Annexure 2 – Slips to play the game.

Slips to play the game: Action mentioned on the slip is to be enacted without speaking.

A child saluting the national flag.

Three wise monkeys of Gandhiji

Showing religious symbols and then joining hands to depict unity.

Act like a soldier defending in a war.

Show girl and boy both should be given equal opportunities.

Someone is writing on a monument (Taj Mahal)

Planting a tree

Throwing stones at streetlights.

Show a cat crossing the path and person stop walking

Act like a person doing all work efficiently. Efficiency can be shown by thumbs up symbol or tick with a hand movement.

A 10 girl not allowed to go to school.

Show a bird flying gets hit and falls. A person helping the bird.

A Traffic police officer not taking bribe.

Show a person damaging public property (streetlight or traffic light)

A person voting.

Person throwing waste in the rivers

Voicing out when you see harm being done to others/nature.

Respectfully stand when national Anthem plays

Stay in brotherhood with one another without fighting

Show apple falls from tree and person thinks why (scientific temper)
