

Annexure 1 – Issue Cards

Teacher can choose any four, extra cards are given in case if class size is larger, and more groups are to be made. If teacher wants entire class to work only on one/two issue, they can also choose that option.

Group 1: You are alone at home, and you notice smoke coming out of your neighbour's window. You carefully notice and observe flames coming out of their kitchen window.

Group 2 While returning from relative's house in evening you noticed suspicious people trying to sneak into your friend's house. You are aware that your friend with family is out for a vacation and the house is empty.

Group 3: While walking on the street you notice the streetlights on during the day. You observe for three days that the lights do not turn off throughout the day. You also checked with other lights in the area, and all of them are also on even during the day.

Group 4: You were on the road, and you see a person on bike snatches away an old lady's purse. You were able to read the vehicle's number plate.

Group 5: You see a gutter near your home overflowing causing bad smell and increase in mosquitoes. You see a person about to slip due to the mess and are worried that people can fall sick.

Group 6: You are walking home from school, and you see that two persons are beating a stray dog very badly. This dog takes shelter near your home and sometimes your neighbours feed it.
