## MUNICIPALITY

Structure:

Municipal Corporation	Municipal Council	Nagar Panchayat

**Role of Municipality in the Urban Development –**

- Construction and maintenance of roads, bridges, and drainage system
- Managing the water supply.
- Ensuring public health and proper sanitation.
- Protecting natural resources and regulating their use.
- Construction of schools in the locality.
- Maintaining birth and death records

Municipality plays as important role with regard to supply of water for the community. As it owns/manages the water supply scheme and is responsible for:

- Creating a plan to ensure that adequate water supply as well as clean and safe drinking water is available to the areas under it.
- Creating a separate budget for it.
- Approving fee charges
- Approving operators and contractors.
- Creating alternative plans for untoward shortage or calamities.
- Co-ordinating with other authorities.
- Hiring trained mechanics for regular preventive maintenance and trained operators for piped water supplies

**Features:**

- There are multiple departments set up to resolve different kinds of issues. For example: Public works department to resolve various issues for water, road safety, etc., Pollution Board looks after various kinds of pollution, Waste Management, etc.
- It plays an important part in urban development by providing accessible clean water, proper sanitation, and infrastructure as well.
- It plans how the budget and funds are to be utilized for development and local administration.
- It ensures responsive actions by the representatives as they are in direct touch with the residents.

**How can you reach the local Municipality?**

- Visit the Local Municipal/Ward Office and discuss the issue as individual/group.
- Write a letter to the concerned authority.
- File an online complaint on the website to register any concerning issue.
- File and RTI to find out more about the issue.

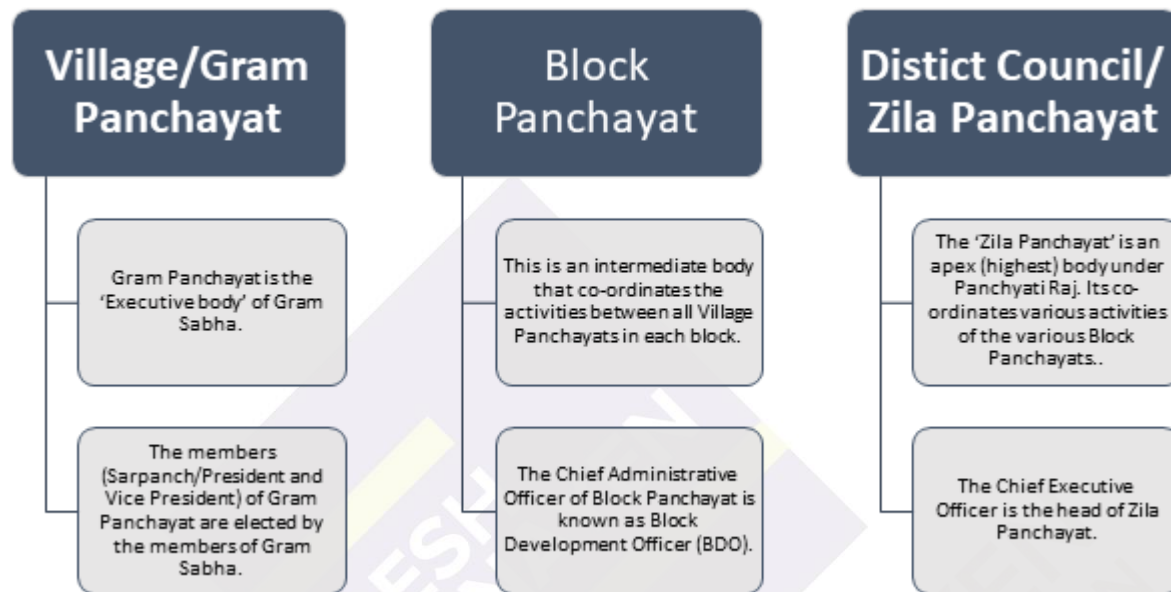

# PANCHAYAT

Structure:



## Role of Panchayat in Rural Development –

- Judicial functions such as trying petty civil and criminal cases such as minor thefts and money disputes are also performed either by separate Justice Panchayat or by Gram Panchayats.
- Providing necessary facilities like sanitation and medical assistance, schools, irrigation, roads, drinking water, etc. to improve living conditions.
- Improving socio-economic welfare through the promotion of rural industries, health, education, women, and child welfare, among others.

**Gram Panchayat (GP):** The GP owns/manages the water supply scheme for the community and is responsible for:

- Estimation of amount of water required.
- Listing of sources of water in the area – conducting audit of water availability.
- Availability and Decision on type of water supply scheme.
- Approving annual budgets and user fee charges after discussion in the Gram Sabha
- Approving operators
- Co-ordinating with other authorities.
- Hiring trained mechanics and operators for regular maintenance for hand pumps piped water supplies.

At some places-

The Pani Samiti/Village Water and Sanitation Committee (VWSC): The VWSC is a standing committee of the GP and is responsible for planning, implementation, operation, maintenance and management of village drinking water security:

- Collecting household contributions and user fees
- Opening and managing a bank account
- Preparing annual budgets and recommendations for user fee charges
- Organizing people to be vigilant about not wasting water and keeping water clean.
- Ensuring professional support for handpump caretakers and piped water supply operators

Features:

- Makes annual developmental plans for the area and prepares schemes for more scientific agriculture, employment generation, etc.
- Most of the decisions are taken by village panchayat meetings.
- Implementing and coordinating schemes launched by the Central and State governments, like the Public Distribution System.
- There are timings for public hearing or Jan Sunvai where the elected members use to come to listen the issues.
- It plays an important part in solving issues among the people as it is aware of the local conditions and accordingly takes responsive actions.
- It plans how the budget and funds are to be utilized for development and local administration.
- Sometimes it also conducts fair for the village and generates revenue as well.

How can you reach the local Panchayat?

- Visit the Local Panchayat Office and discuss the issue as an individual/group.
- Write a letter to the concerned authority.
- File an online complaint on the website to register any concerning issue if your state has.
- You can meet the Panch of your area.
- File and RTI to find out more about the issue.
